“Mobile Food Vending” means the setting up or use within the road reserve or any box shall stand barrow or stationary vehicle other than a roadside stall or mobile vending machine defined hereunder for the purpose of offering for sale any goods or for the pursuit of any business calling or employment

1. Stalls stands stationary vehicles and the like used for the preparation storage or sale of food for human consumption shall comply with the relevant requirements for Council’s Guidelines for the “Hygienic Operation of Food Vending Vehicles, Temporary Food Premises or Food-stalls”.
2. Application for a permit to trade shall be made on the prescribed form and shall specify the location within the municipality where it is intended to or sell goods
3. A person who sells food for human consumption shall not do so within 200 metres of any trading shop that sells similar goods or articles of food.
4. Stalls, stands, stationary vehicles, goods, and the like displayed shall be placed so as to minimize any risk or injury being caused to premises by and be so placed as to be clear from any other obstructions including bus stops, approved advertisements and the like and the minimum unobstructed footpath width of 2500mm shall at all times be maintained
5. Stalls, stands stationary vehicles, goods, and the like displayed that are considered to be a danger to the public if not removed upon request may be impounded and if not claimed and the impounding fee as determined by Council not paid within fourteen (14) days from the date of impounding will be disposed of as Council deems appropriate
6. The issue of any permit to trade will be subject to terms and conditions as determined by Council or its authorised Officer
7. Approval of the NSW Roads and Traffic Authority (RTA) either directly or through Councils Local Traffic Committee, must first be obtained for all street vending on all classified roads which, in the Municipality of Ashfield are Liverpool Road, Ramsay Street, Parramatta Road, Frederick Street, Milton Street, and Old Canterbury Road
8. No person shall display or sort food for sale in any street or other open space at a level lower than 75centimetres above the footpath level or ground level in the case of such street or open space, unless such food is adequately protected against pollution by dogs cats or other animals
9. The Council is indemnified of all responsibility for the use for which this application refers and the applicant agrees to accept all responsibility
10. All liquid waste is to be disposed of to the sewer in accordance with Sydney Water requirements
11. Permit is immediately invalid if no Current indemnity insurance is in force.
12. Subject Vehicle to be maintained in good repair and hygienic condition at all times when vending is being carried out.
13. Vehicle must display valid Safe Food Approval.
14. All food businesses in NSW must notify their details to the NSW food authority. On line notification can be completed at www.foodnotify.nsw.gov.au.
